## 2015 Annual Report January 2016

2015 was an incredible year for our organization. In May we were not sure we could stay open, and by December we knew we not only could, but should stay open and had a new Executive Director, and renewed vision and direction from the Lord. Here are some of the highlights of the year (from May to December):

- Began what has become the ongoing “rearrange the Center” project!
- Began a printer cartridge recycling program
- Created a database of all our clients from 2008 to present (all the post-fire clients)
- Requested and received a grant from Yampa Valley Community Foundation
- Began talks to have our *Earn While You Learn* modules become part of the electives curriculum at GOAL Academy (first students came January 11, 2016).
- **We changed our name!** We are now Yampa Valley Pregnancy & Family Center – it better reflects who we serve...pregnant teens and women; single parents, couples, grandparents and foster parents raising infants and toddlers.
- I was asked to serve on Judge Gardner’s Family Treatment Court Resource Committee. *Earn While You Learn* modules will be offered as part of the Family Treatment Court program when it is initiated.
- I am talking with the Department of Social Services to offer *Earn While You Learn* modules to their foster parents as part of their ongoing training and support.

- Financially we did well. We received \$12,712 from private donors and \$3,503 from churches. Our fundraising efforts generated \$10,108, and we received a \$2,000 grant from Yampa Valley Community Foundation.
