## 2016 Annual Report

January 2017



We have had an incredible 2016 at the Pregnancy & Family Center. The Lord has blessed us more than we even knew to ask or think! Here are some of the highlights:

- Continued our “rearrange the Center” project! We now have 4 clothes racks each with a 5’ wire basket on top for all our infant, toddler and maternity clothes and accessory items.
- Received \$8,500 in grant money from Yampa Valley Community Foundation, Moffat County United Way, and Moffat County Human Resource Council.
- Completed our first set of *Earn While You Learn* Life Skills modules as part of Love INC’s *Faith and Finances* classes. We will begin another set in January or February.
- Began advertising with Parrot Films at The West Theater.
- Published one newsletter – planning on doing better this year!
- Added 4 volunteers; 1 is the “manager” of our Practical Needs Store
- Created our first Business Plan that includes
  - Beginning to form a Teen Council as part of our Board of Directors to help us reach teens in high school with a message of abstinence to help reduce the number of teen pregnancies in Craig, and support during pregnancy for at risk teens to help them choose life.
  - Beginning a Community Outreach Committee that will help us stay better connected to our churches, reach out to businesses, agencies and the college
  - Be more proactive keeping in touch with our donors
  - Formed a Social Media Committee with a goal of establishing and maintaining a business FaceBook page and maintaining our website.
- Financially we did well. We received \$\$6,695 from private donors, \$2,452 from local businesses, and \$5,217 from churches. Our fundraising efforts generated \$4,814 (we were not able to hold our annual Chili Supper and Silent Auction because we received a grant from Moffat County United Way and agreed not to raise funds during their campaign), and we received a \$2,500 grant from Yampa Valley Community Foundation, and \$3,000 each from Moffat County United Way and the Human Resource Council.
- ***What we are asking the Lord for in 2017:*** More volunteers so we can be open more hours, men who will mentor our dads and (hopefully) start a class for men affected by abortion, a way to reach women who have been affected by abortion and offer them hope and healing through recovery classes; regular monthly donations that will cover our operating expenses (we are about \$800 short each month) and favor with grant makers at the Rural Philanthropy Days in September.
- Finally, on the back of this report are some statistics that reflect the life of the Center from 2008 to 2016. We are definitely growing!!

A huge thank you to everyone who has supported us with prayers and financial giving. We are partners in this ministry, and we appreciate you so much!
